Dr Angus Chan graduated from the University of Glasgow, UK. He had extensive training in General Practice and most of his postgraduate assignments were at Professorial units in Scotland. He returned to Hong Kong in 1996 and was awarded the Fellowship of Hong Kong Academy of Medicine in 2001.

Dr Chan was the Chairman of the Specialty Examination Board, Hong Kong College of Family Physicians from 2007 to 2010. He was instrumental in modifying the Exit Examination which included consultation skills, practice assessment, clinical audit and introduced research segment as part of the assessment. He was Vice President (Education and Examination) from 2011 to 2014 and is the President of the College from 2015 till now.
