Professor Chris Griffith obtained a BSc and PhD in Medical Microbiology from Liverpool University and has worked in hospitals in the USA and Sweden. He has applied Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points (HACCP) and other risk management tools ,widely used in the food industry , to infection prevention . He has published extensively on the use of novel approaches and technologies to improve hospital cleaning . His main current research area of interest is the application of "organisational culture" and related topics in understanding and then improving compliance with infection prevention practices .

He has been awarded numerous international awards and has authored / co-authored more than 400 publications. He is editor of the British Food Journal and on the editorial board of the American Journal of Infection Control( AJIC). He is a member of the communicable disease committee of the IAFP and worked with the Royal Institute of Public Health for 10 years on aspects of infection prevention .

He managed a research and consultancy unit within the Cardiff School of Health Sciences at the University of Wales for 15 years and attracted grants worth £1.85 million. He now works internationally as a consultant and trainer and is the Technical Director of Von Holy Consulting.
