Margaret IP is a Professor at the Department of Microbiology, Chinese University of Hong Kong and an Honorary Consultant at the Prince of Wales Hospital, Shatin, Hong Kong. She is a clinical microbiologist with over 20 years' experience in research on the clinical and molecular epidemiology and antimicrobial resistance of important Gram-positive pathogens, with special interests in Group B streptococcus (*S. agalactiae*), *Streptococcus pneumoniae* and methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA). Her research group consists of young postdoctoral scientists and PhD students, and besides tracking changes in relation to colonisation and infection serotypes, virulence, resistance determinants acquisitions of these bacteria in health and disease, the team also focuses on applications of new diagnostic tools, WGS and metagenomics, biomarkers and molecules from traditional Chinese medicine in targeting these infections. She has published over 200 peer-reviewed papers and book chapters and is Associate Editor to *Frontiers in Microbiology/Medicine/Public Health* amongst others.
