Patient Engagement on Hand Hygiene Program - From Planning to Implementation Prince of Wales Hospital, HK

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Overview

- Hand hygiene is a single most important strategy to prevent hospital acquired infection.
- The WHO Guidelines on Hand Hygiene in Health Care (2009) encourage partnership between patients, their families, and health-care workers to promote hand hygiene in health-care settings.

Hong Kong Strategy and Action Plan on Antimicrobial Resistance 2017-2022

Strategic Interventions

- 9.1 <u>Strengthen infection control training among healthcare workers</u>
 - Training and education materials will be developed to promulgate standards and good practice to healthcare professionals and allied healthcare personnel. Infection control training will continue to be provided to new intakes of healthcare workers under HA with regular refresher courses.
 - While the responsibility for hand hygiene rests with the healthcare worker, as part of a multimodal hand hygiene improvement strategy as advocated by WHO's Guidelines on Hand Hygiene in Health Care⁴⁰, positive engagement with patients in the pursuit of improving hand hygiene compliance by healthcare workers will also be promoted. Studies have shown that organisation culture and staff perception are essential in patient empowerment programmes. Training to raise awareness and solicit healthcare workers' support for patient engagement programmes on reminding healthcare workers to perform hand hygiene will also be conducted. Researches or review of literature will be needed to provide insight to what is achievable in the local community. Patient engagement in hand hygiene is recognised as an important part in improving hand hygiene among healthcare workers. The acceptability and benefits of various forms of patient engagement in hand hygiene compliance will be explored in HA hospitals.









 Q1:If the hospital invite you to remind HCWs to clean theirs hands before caring you, are you able to do so ?



 Q3:Would you ask the HCW to clean their hands before taking care you if you see they missed ?




Q 1.1 Reasons of being unable to remind HCWs %





- Patients and their relatives are encouraged to collaborate with hospital staff during treatment and investigation procedures to ensure patients' safe and speedy recovery.
- b. <u>Infection Control Measures:</u> Patients with infectious risks may be required to be transferred to different wards with enhanced infection control facilities, thereby minimizing cross infection within the hospital premises. In addition, to protect yourself and safeguard public health, please undertake precautionary measures such as wearing a surgical mask if you have respiratory symptoms; and perform hand hygiene before eating, taking medicine and after using toilet. Our health care workers are also required to clean their hands before and after taking care of patients. If you are aware of any healthcare staff not doing so, please make a friendly reminder to them.




Overall Hand Hygiene Compliance of PWH
