

BIOGRAPHY – Dr Cheng Wai Tsoi Frankie

Dr. Frankie Cheng is Associate Consultant in Division of Haematology, Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplantation, Department of Paediatrics, Prince of Wales Hospital. He is also appointed as Honorary Clinical Associate Professor of Department of Paediatrics of the Chinese University of Hong Kong.

Dr. Cheng obtained his medical degree (M.B.,Ch.B) with honors from the Chinese University of Hong Kong in 1998 and has completed paediatric training in Prince of Wales Hospital, Hong Kong. He obtained the Fellowship of the Hong Kong College of Paediatricians and the Fellowship of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine (Paediatrics) in 2006. He awarded the degree of Doctor of Medicine (MD) in 2010 with thesis title “Strategies for Prevention of Infection in Pediatric Oncology Patients and Hematopoietic Stem Cell Transplant Recipients”.

He received oversea fellowship training in paediatric infectious diseases and stem cell transplantation in the Division of Infectious Diseases, Hospital for Sick Children, Toronto, Canada in 2004 and Division of Bone Marrow Transplantation and Cellular Therapy, St. Jude Children’s Research Hospital in 2009.

Dr. Cheng’s primary research interests are infectious diseases and immune recovery in immunocompromised patients, including cancer and stem cell transplant patients. He had more than sixty publications in these fields in world-leading peer-review journals.
