Dr Fluck was trained at Cambridge and the Royal London Hospital. He was appointed Research Fellow and British Heart Foundation Fellow at St Bartholomew's, before appointment to the Royal London Hospital as lecturer in Medicine. In 1996, Dr Fluck was appointed Consultant Renal Physician in Derby.

Dr Fluck currently is the Clinical Lead in Derby, Clinical Director for the East Midlands Renal Network, President elect of the British Renal Society and advisor to the Department of Health on Renal Related Infections. Dr Fluck research interests include vascular access, infection and quality improvement in dialysis.
