Prof. Emily A Blumberg is a Professor of Medicine in the Division of Infectious Diseases at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania, where she is the Director of Transplant Infectious Diseases and the Infectious Diseases Fellowship Program Director. She is the former chair of the OPTN/UNOS Ad Hoc Disease Transmission Advisory Committee (DTAC) and has been extensively involved in the development of guidelines for the prevention of donor derived infections to solid organ transplant recipients, participating in several consensus conferences regarding testing and other strategies for prevention of disease transmission. Her research focus is on donor derived infections and viral infections in transplant recipients, including HIV and HCV. She is an Associate Editor for the American Journal of Transplantation, Liver Transplantation, and Transplant Infectious Diseases. She is a former Board Member of the American Society of Transplantation (AST) and a former Chair of the Infectious Diseases Community of Practice of the AST.
